LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY #4 OF 2008 – LAKE LAW

Michael Donnelly, Esq. raised the issue on the need for clarification and distinction between permanent and non-permanent structures and docks as well as grandfathering and the requirement for documentation (with pictures). A discussion was held on these issues as well as amendments to the language in the proposed law.

Also discussed was the Village Boat Club's application for a new dock.
