The Causeway Wall

I have spoken to TuxedoTown Supervisor Dolan regarding the use of the town facility on Longmeadow Road for leaf disposal. As the town is still working on complying with DEC requirements that were to be in place by September 1st, the town will not be taking any leaves into that facility. We are working with the DPW on a cost effective way to collect leaves from the residents and landscapers and dispose of them. We will keep you posted on this.

Trees:

We are asking residents to please keep an eye out for dead trees, limbs, etc. That might cause damage in high winds or any severe storms. Look out for those especially close to the roads and your houses or buildings. It is easy to identify them now and have someone remove them as soon as possible. We ask that if there is a questionable situation to please bring it to the attention of John Ledwith at the Village Office so he can notify O&R or Verizon if needed.
