

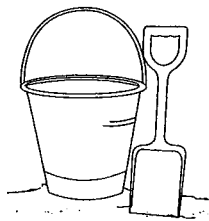

We are writing to you at this time with an update on the status of our club and we are excited to tell you that Wee Wah Lake is full of water! After being closed for all of last season the executive board is happy to report that the Wee Wah Beach Club will open again this year. Starting on June 15th and for the remainder of June we will be open on weekends for picnicking and playground activities. In addition, we are also currently applying for our swimming permit from the Orange County Dept. of Health and we are hopeful that the Village of Tuxedo Park will allow us to swim in the not too distant future. We will be charging the full membership rates in anticipation of hiring lifeguards and other costs associated with swimming. If, however, swimming is not approved, members will be able to request a partial refund of their membership fee at the end of the season. This will be our 85th anniversary. Please help us

Please note that the Carry In/Carry Out policy will be strictly enforced in 2019

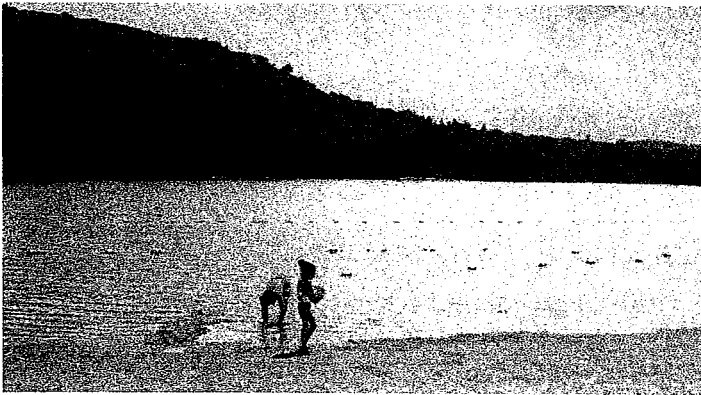


The club's constitution allows us to send official notices via email.

**In the event that swimming is permitted, the following rules apply*

Swimming Hours

Due to liability concerns and Department of Health regulations, **no bathers may remain in the water past 8 pm or any other time there is insufficient visibility.**

Please note that swimming is not available while the lifeguard is setting up and storing our safety equipment. Also, **all members and guests must leave the Beach Club premises when the lifeguard locks the gate. NO ONE MAY REMAIN ON BEACH CLUB PROPERTY WITHOUT A LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.**

Please note: For safety reasons, the lifeguard on duty will take mandated breaks during the course of the day. **No one will be permitted in the water during the lifeguard's breaks!** We ask your cooperation in this important safety issue.

Rules & Regulations

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind our members to review the rules of the Beach, which are included with this letter.

Please note: For the safety of all members, beach employees will follow these guidelines:

- * A person breaking a rule will be given a warning.
- * If the person continues to break the rules, s/he may be removed from the Beach for a specific amount of time.

Please remind your children and guests that the beach employees are the final authority at the Beach, and their directions must be followed at all times!

If patrons continue to break beach rules, the Executive Committee will decide on one of the following two options:

1. Minor children must be accompanied to the beach by their parent, regardless of their age.
2. In the case of serious or continual infractions, the family's membership will be rescinded for the remainder of the season, and no refund will be given

Dues

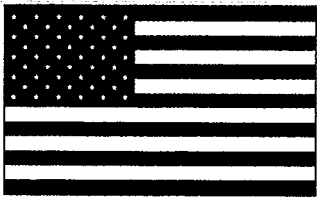
Membership categories and our guest policy are included in this letter on a separate page. Dues are listed on our registration sheet.

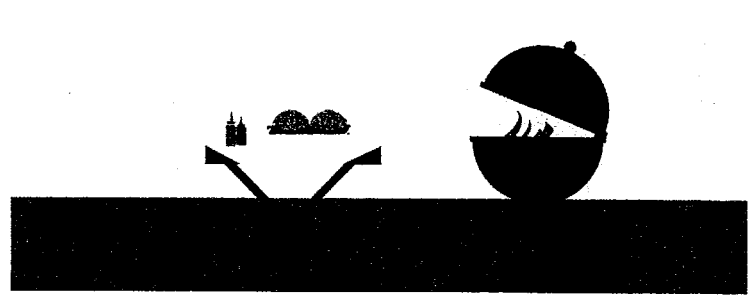

FOURTH OF JULY

In an effort to address some concerns presented by members, the Executive Board of the Wee Wah Beach Club has decided on the following policy for the July 4th, 2019 Holiday.

- * Beach picnic tables cannot be reserved prior to the opening of the Beach at 9:00am on July 4th. Any items placed on tables prior to that time will be removed. Approximately five minutes before the opening of the Beach on July 4th, senior citizens (or anyone needing special consideration) will be allowed to select a table.
- * There is a limit of 1 beach table per membership; members are encouraged to bring their own tables.
- * Additional parking will be available near the DPW. All members are urged to carpool. Please remember that only Beach members (not guests) are allowed to park in the Beach parking lot.
- * For the July 4th weekend, members with guest passes may choose to either use their guest passes for guests **OR** pay \$3.00 per guest (all ages are charged \$3.00).

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

***FULL FAMILY:** For parents & dependent children or couples. Dependent children include students 22 and under. Caregivers are NOT included.

***SINGLE:** For single adults with no dependent children.

ADULT CHILD SINGLE: For single adults living in a member household.

***SENIOR CITIZEN:** Available to FORMER MEMBERS who have reached the age of 65. Senior citizens who have never been a member of the Beach Club must pay regular rates for one year before becoming eligible for senior citizen membership in their second year.

***ARMED FORCES & CLERGY:** Available at no charge to full-time active members of the armed forces, clergy, their spouses and dependent children.

*Guest privileges available for these membership categories.

GUEST FEES & POLICY

\$45 for 10 guest passes

\$55 for 20 guest passes

Guest cards are kept at the checker's station at the Beach, not mailed to members.

1. People who are eligible to be members (i.e. residents of the Park and hamlet) MAY NOT be guests.
2. Members **MUST** accompany their guests to the Beach, sign them in with the checker on duty and remain with their guests. Any member who fails to do so risks the loss of guest privileges.
3. Members must have guest privileges to bring any guests, no matter the age of the guest.
4. Members must be at least 18 years old to sign in a guest.
5. Children 12 and under do not count toward your total number of guests, but they must be signed in with the checker. Senior citizens **DO** count toward the total number of guests.
6. Please familiarize yourself and your guests with the Beach rules as you are responsible for your guests while they are at the Beach.
7. **Guests should park their cars outside the gate on weekends and holidays.**

RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE WEE WAH BEACH CLUB

1. Swimming is prohibited after 8:00 PM or 30 minutes before sunset, whichever is earlier, and at any time a lifeguard is not on duty. No one is allowed on the premises when the gate is locked; the beach is then officially closed.
2. Non-swimmers may not be on the waterfront without the direct supervision of a parent, guardian or babysitter. Please check with a lifeguard regarding your child's swimming ability.
3. Children who have not completed 6th grade are not allowed at the beach facility unless they are supervised by a parent, guardian or babysitter. Babysitters must be at least 13 years old.
4. Children who have completed 6th grade may be at the beach without supervision provided they abide by all beach rules. Inappropriate or unsafe behavior will not be tolerated.
5. No swimming beyond the roped area.
6. Jumping off the dock or walls is prohibited.
7. Swimming under the raft or rough play on the raft is prohibited.
8. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
9. Tubes, rafts, inflatables, snorkels, fins, masks, balls and life preservers are not permitted in the water.
10. No glass containers allowed in the sand area or beachfront. Use picnic area for meals.
11. Animals are not allowed on the beach grounds at any time.
12. Ball playing is permitted on the grass area only, not in the sand.
13. No loud music shall be played.
14. Proper attire is to be worn at all times.
15. No boats, rafts etc. may be launched from or landed on beach property.
16. Everyone must take their trash with them when they leave.
17. No one under 21 is allowed to have alcoholic beverages at the beach.
18. Anyone destroying or defacing property will be held responsible for payment and may lose membership privileges.
19. Membership in the Beach Club does not include membership in the Wee Wah Fishing Club. Fishing is prohibited at the beach.
20. Wee Wah employees are the authority at the beach and their instructions are to be followed at all times.
21. The Executive Board may suspend anyone who violates the rules listed above. Membership fees will not be returned.
